

EMPLOYERS FOR CHRIST: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

The word baptism implies being immersed so in view of the baptism in the Holy Spirit, it implies being immersed in (filled by) and saturated (overflowing) with the Holy Spirit and with the power of the Holy Spirit to spread the Good News.

KEY POINT: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THE GIFT FROM THE FATHER

Ditiro tša Baapostola 1:4-5 / IzEnzo 1:4-5 / Acts 1:4-5 “4 On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

KEY POINT: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT IS FOR THE BELIEVER TO BE FULL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Baefeso 5:18 / Kwabase-Efesu 5:18 / Ephesians 5:18 “Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit,”

KEY POINT: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT EMPOWERS THE BELIEVER FOR SERVICE

Ditiro tša Baapostola 1:8 / IzEnzo 1:8 / Acts 1:8 “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Luka 24:49 / NgokukaLuka 24:49 / Luke 24:49 “I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.”

KEY POINT: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT REVEALS THE SPIRITUAL GIFT OF THE BELIEVER

1 Bakorinthe 12:4 / 1 kwabaseKorinte 12:4 / 1 Corinthians 12:4 “There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them.”

KEY POINT: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT IS SIGNIFIED BY EVIDENCE OF SPEAKING IN TONGUES

Ditiro tša Baapostola 2:4 / IzEnzo 2:4 / Acts 2:4 “All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.”

KEY POINT: BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT CAN BE RECEIVED BY ASKING THE FATHER

Luka 11:13 / NgokukaLuka 11:13 / Luke 11:13 “If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!”

REMEMBER:

1. Baptism in the Holy Spirit is the gift from the Father
2. Baptism in the Holy Spirit is for the believer to be full of the Holy Spirit
3. Baptism in the Holy Spirit empowers the believer for service
4. Baptism in the Holy Spirit reveals the spiritual gift of the believer
5. Baptism in the Holy Spirit is signified by evidence of speaking in tongues
6. Baptism in the Holy Spirit can be received by asking the Father
