KEY POINT: GOD INSTRUCTED US TO WORK AND TAKE CARE OF HIS CREATION

KEY POINT: GOD INSTRUCTED US TO RULE OVER HIS CREATION

Genesi 1:28 / UGenesis 1:28 / Genesis 1:28 "God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

KEY POINT: WHY SHOULD YOU CARE? CHRIST DIED TO RECONCILE ALL OF CREATION TO GOD

Bakolose 1:20 / KwabaseKolose 1:20 / Colossians 1:20 "and through Him to reconcile to Himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through His blood, shed on the cross."

KEY POINT: WHY SHOULD YOU CARE? ALL OF CREATION BELONGS TO JESUS

Bakolose 1:16 / KwabaseKolose 1:16 / Colossians 1:16 "For by Him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by Him and for Him."

KEY POINT: PRACTICAL WAYS OF CARING FOR GOD'S CREATION

1. Plant trees.
2. Do not litter.
3. Fix water leaks.
4. Do not pollute the air with gasses.
5. Turn off electrical devices when they are not in use.
