KEY POINT: LAW VERSUS GRACE

Baroma 6:14 / KwabaseRoma 6:14 / Romans 6:14 "Sin must not be your master; for you do not live under law but under God's grace.

KEY POINT: GOD SAVES US BECAUSE OF HIS GRACE

Baefeso 2:4,5 / Kwabase-Efesu 2:4,5 / Efhesians 2:4,5 "4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved."

KEY POINT: IF WE RECEIVED HIS GRACE, WE MUST STAY IN IT

Di tiro tša Baapostola 13:43 / IzEnzo 13:43 / Acts 13:43 "When the congregation was dismissed, many of the Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who talked with them and urged them to continue in the grace of God."

KEY POINT: WE ARE NOT ENTITLED TO BOAST IN OURSELVES, IT IS ONLY GRACE

1 Bakorinthe 15:10 / 1 kwabaseKorinte 15:10 / 1 Corinthians 15:10 "But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace to me was not without effect. No, I worked harder than all of them—yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me."

KEY POINT: IF WE GO THROUGH TRIBULATIONS, GOD'S GRACE IS ENOUGH FOR US

2 Bakorinthe 12:9 / 2 kwabaseKorinte 12:9 / 2 Corinthians 12:9 "But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness. "Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

REMEMBER:

1. Law versus grace
2. God saves us because of His grace
3. If we received His grace , we must stay in it
4. We are not entitled to boast in ourselves, it is only grace
5. If we go through tribulations, God's grace is enough for us
