KEY POINT: HOPE IS DEPENDENT ON KNOWING THE WORD OF GOD

Baroma 15:4 / KwabaseRoma 15:4 / Romans 15:4 “For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope.”

KEY POINT: HOPE IS DEPENDENT ON A SPIRIT FILLED LIFE

Baroma 15:13 / KwabaseRoma 15:13 / Romans 15:13 “May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.”

KEY POINT: YOUR ONLY TRUE HOPE MUST ALWAYS BE IN GOD

Dipsalme 62:5 / AmaHubo 62:5 / Psalm 62:5 “Yes, my soul, find rest in God; my hope comes from him.”

Jesaya 41:10 / Uisaya 41:10 / Isaiah 41:10 “So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.”

REMEMBER:

1. Hope is dependent on a living relationship with God
2. Hope is dependent on knowing the word of God
3. Hope is dependent on a spirit filled life
4. Your only true hope must always be in God
