KEY POINT: JESUS ASSOCIATED WITH SINNERS

Luka 15:1-2 / NgokukaLuka 15:1-2 / Luke 15:1-2 “1 Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. 2 But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, “This man welcomes sinners and eats with them.”

KEY POINT: YOU CANNOT BE JUDGMENTAL TOWARDS PEOPLE AROUND YOU

Mateo 7:1-2 / NgokukaMathewu 7:1-2 / Matthew 7:1-2 “1 “Do not judge, or you too will be judged. 2 For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”

KEY POINT: YOU NEED TO BE THE LIGHT AND SALT TO PEOPLE AROUND YOU

Mareka 9:50 / NgokukaMarku 9:50 / Mark 9:50 “Salt is good, but if it loses its saltiness, how can you make it salty again? Have salt among yourselves, and be at peace with each other.”

KEY POINT: YOU ARE NOT EXCLUDED FROM THE DIFFICULTIES OF THIS WORLD

Johane 16:33 / NgokukaJohane 16:33 / John 16:33 “I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

KEY POINT: YOU NEED TO DETERMINE WHAT GOD'S WILL FOR YOUR LIFE IS

Baroma 12:2 / KwabaseRoma 12:2 / Romans 12:2 “Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is — his good, pleasing and perfect will.”

REMEMBER:

1. Jesus associated with sinners
2. You cannot be judgmental towards people around you
3. You need to be the light and salt to people around you
4. You are not excluded from the difficulties of this world
5. You need to determine what God's will for your life is

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
