KEY POINT: THE SECOND AND GREAT COMMANDMENT

Mateo 22:39 / NgokukaMathewu 22:39 / Matthew 22:39 “And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbour as yourself’.”

KEY POINT: COMMANDMENT FIVE IS ABOUT RESPECT FOR PARENTAL AUTHORITY

Ekisodo 20:12 / UEksodusi 20:12 / Exodus 20:12 “Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.”

KEY POINT: COMMANDMENT SIX IS ABOUT RESPECT FOR HUMAN LIFE

Ekisodo 20:13 / UEksodusi 20:13 / Exodus 20:13 “You shall not murder.”

KEY POINT: COMMANDMENT SEVEN IS ABOUT PURITY IN RELATIONSHIP

Ekisodo 20:14 / UEksodusi 20:14 / Exodus 20:14 “You shall not commit adultery.”

KEY POINT: COMMANDMENT EIGHT IS ABOUT HONESTY

Ekisodo 20:15 / UEksodusi 20:15 / Exodus 20:15 “You shall not steal.”

KEY POINT: COMMANDMENT NINE IS ABOUT TRUTHFULNESS

Ekisodo 20:16 / UEksodusi 20:16 / Exodus 20:16 “You shall not give false testimony against your neighbour.”

KEY POINT: COMMANDMENT TEN IS ABOUT CONTENTMENT

Ekisodo 20:17 / UEksodusi 20:17 / Exodus 20:17 “You shall not covet your neighbour’s house. You shall not covet your neighbour’s wife, or his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbour.”

3. Commandment six is about respect for human life
4. Commandment seven is about purity in relationship
5. Commandment eight is about honesty
6. Commandment nine is about truthfulness
