

EMPLOYERS FOR CHRIST: THE TRINITY

Parable: When we look at a burning candle we see the wax, the flame and the wick. Even though we see three completely different parts, we still see only one candle.

KEY POINT: IF WE UNDERSTOOD ALL ABOUT GOD HE WOULD NOT BE GOD

Doiteronomio 29:29 / UDuteronomi 29:29 / Deuteronomy 29:29 “The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may follow all the words of this law.”

KEY POINT: JESUS’ BAPTISM PROOFS THE TRINITY

Mateo 3:16-17 / NgokukaMathewu 3:16-17 / Matthew 3:16-17 “**16** As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. **17** And a voice from heaven said, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.”

KEY POINT: JESUS TALKED ABOUT THE TRINITY

Johane 14:26 / NgokukaJohane 14:26 / John 14:26 “But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.”

KEY POINT: PAUL REFERS TO THE TRINITY IN HIS LETTER

1 Bathesalonika 5:18-19 / 1 kwabase-Thesalonika 5:18-19 / 1 Thessalonians 5:18-19 “**18** give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus. **19** Do not quench the Spirit.”

KEY POINT: PAUL REFERS TO THE TRINITY IN HIS REQUEST

Baroma 15:30 / KwabaseRoma 15:30 / Romans 15:30 “I urge you, brothers and sisters, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me.”

REMEMBER:

1. If we understood all about God he would not be God
2. Jesus’ baptism proves the Trinity
3. Jesus talked about the Trinity
4. Paul refers to the Trinity in his letter
5. Paul refers to the Trinity in his request
