

EMPLOYERS FOR CHRIST: THE MEANING OF GOODNESS

Definition of goodness: Ready to do good and love in action.

KEY POINT: THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT IS GOODNESS

Bagalatia 5:22-23 / KwabaseGalathiya 5:22-23 / Galatians 5:22-23 “22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.”

KEY POINT: GOD IS THE SOURCE OF ALL GOOD

Ekisodo 33:19 / UEksodusi 33:19 / Exodus 33:19 “And the Lord said, “I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim my name, the Lord, in your presence. I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.”

KEY POINT: GOODNESS ALSO INCLUDES CORRECTION

Baroma 15:14 KwabaseRoma 15:14 / Romans 15:14 “I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another.”

KEY POINT: A GOOD PERSON WILL STILL HAVE FAILURES

Dipsalme 51:1 / AmaHubo 51:1 / Psalm 51:1 “Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions.”

KEY POINT: YOU NEED TO WORK TOWARDS GOODNESS EACH DAY

Bafilipi 3:14 / KwabaseFilipi 3:14 / Philippians 3:14 “I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.”

KEY POINT: PRACTISE GOODNESS

1. Do something good for someone else
2. Say something to someone that will build them up
3. Provide support to your colleague or manager in difficult times by praying for them
4. Help your colleague or manager with his/her daily tasks

REMEMBER:

1. The fruit of the Spirit is goodness
2. God is the source of all good
3. Goodness also includes correction
4. A good person will still have failures
5. You need to work towards goodness each day
6. Practise goodness
