

EMPLOYERS FOR CHRIST: MANAGING YOUR DAILY CONFLICTS

Statement: The key to managing your daily conflicts is the willingness to follow a biblical plan.

KEY POINT: BRING GOD INTO THE SITUATION BY LIVING IN GODLY CHARACTER

1 Bakorinthe 10:31 / 1 kwabaseKorinte 10:31 / 1 Corinthians 10:31 “So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.”

KEY POINT: DID YOU OFFEND? BE OPEN, HONEST AND SEEK FORGIVENESS

Mateo 7:5 / NgokukaMathewu 7:5 / Matthew 7:5 “You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.”

KEY POINT: ASK GOD TO SHOW YOU YOUR PART IN THE CONFLICT

Mateo 5:23-24 / NgokukaMathewu 5:23-24 / Matthew 5:23-24 “**23** Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, **24** leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother; then come and offer your gift.”

KEY POINT: COMMIT TO RESOLVE THE CONFLICT WITH LOVE AND FORGIVENESS

Bagalatia 6:1 / KwabaseGalathiya 6:1 / Galatians 6:1 “Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted.”

KEY POINT: ALWAYS LOOK FOR A BIBLICAL SOLUTION

Jakobo 5:16 / EkaJakobe 5:16 / James 5:16 “Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.”

REMEMBER:

1. Bring God into conflict situations by living in Godly character
2. Be open, honest and seek forgiveness if you have offended someone
3. Ask God to show you your part in the conflict
4. Commit yourself to resolve the conflict with love and forgiveness
5. Always look for a biblical solution

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
